Case Study

Architrail alongside partners Capita Symonds and Dinsdale's were commissioned to deliver an off road cycling centre study around the historic Ashton Court Estate in Bristol.

The study, which was part of the 1SW cycling project, involved an assessment of the existing site and the design and specification of approximately 6km of red and blue graded mountain bike trails.

In particular the site was a designated Historic Park and Garden also a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) which presented multiple challenges for the design team.

The consultation process included Natural England, Forestry Commission, The National Trust, Local Planning Authority, English Heritage and local off road cycling groups.

Ecological constraints were overcome and innovative designs including a cycle roundabout and trail formations to cause limited impact to a stand of important veteran trees.
