

Case Study

The school's cycling club secured funding for a mountain biking facility to be used for recreational, educational and competition use.

DMS and Architrail undertook consultation with the club coaches, school governor's and teachers as well as the children themselves. We produced a detailed design for a trail around the school field's perimeter that would not encroach on existing sports pitches.

The project also included student teaching sessions by Architrail as well as tutorials on MTB trail design leading to a term long assignment on mountain biking.

The finished trail contains 32 separate technical trail features (TTF) and has been designed to help cycling coaches develop young riders off road skills.

TTF include, berms, rollers, rock gardens, drop-offs and jumps.

The trail will now be used for inter school sports activities including cycling and off road running.
