

Case Study

Working closely with the client and local MTB group DMS and Architrail designed and built two types of trails creating a figure of eight circuit within the woodland.

The new trails have been designed for downhill riders and cross country MTB riders. Working closely with our partners Architrail and Capita Symonds we designed and constructed the 'Tricky Sixty Trail' which includes 60 berms in six hundred metres and the cross country 'Tale of Two Trees' trail with two sections of north shore. Other Technical Trail Features included berm's, drop off, jumps, table tops, rollers and sections of rock farm.

The shape of the trail and some technical features where created by two 360 tracked excavators apart from the difficult to access areas and stone/timber TTF which were hand built.

The projects were completed within the deadline and on budget. Our combined expertise enabled a professionally managed project which has delivered fantastic results.
