Billinge Wood Trails, Witton Country Park, Blackburn, Lancashire

The Witton Country Park MTB trail on Billinge Hill descends approximately 50m over a distance of 700m. Red-graded, the trail contains 60 turns along its length and is suitable for riders with a reasonable experience of mountain biking ability on technical and difficult terrain.

Designed to be a highly sustainable track the wear and tear of erosional forces created by cyclists was accommodated using advanced trail design techniques. The distribution and type of turns control the maximum speed riders can attain and therefore limit braking and erosion hot spots. This control of speed also minimises risk to riders themselves and other woodland users. Wherever possible the trail uses existing exposed sections of gritstone and sandstone bedrock. Boulders were inlaid into sections where high wear could be predicted. Drainage was carefully planned and implemented to avoid any standing water on, or adjacent to, the track







